The faculty member in this position will be responsible for research, advising, service, and involvement in academic programming at the undergraduate and graduate levels in the field of Retailing and Consumer Science. Scholarly and/or practitioner experience in the areas of international retailing and e-tailing is preferred. A successful publication record in peerreviewed journals is preferred. A doctorate or ABD is expected. The Department of Human Development and Consumer Sciences has a vibrant and productive faculty, a robust undergraduate program in two fields and a graduate program in Global Retailing as well as two other fields. The undergraduate retailing program is offered both in the classroom and online allowing students to complete studies in either or both venues. Applicants must submit a current resume (or curriculum vitae); a letter describing the candidate's interest in and qualifications for the position, exhibiting the potential for exceptional research, excellence in teaching, and a clear commitment to enhancing the diversity and inclusiveness of the faculty, graduate, and undergraduate student population; two representative papers; and three references with contact information. This position is anticipated to begin September 1, 2019. Review of applications will begin January 30 and continue until the position is filled.
